

## Wedding Ceremonies

- ◆ Weddings are held in the gardens.
- ◆ Weddings are held during open hours. Participants must leave the site by 4:30 pm.
- ◆ Cost is \$5 per person plus a \$50 deposit.
- ◆ Chairs can be set up for an additional fee of \$50.
- ◆ A rehearsal may be scheduled in advance and is included in the facility rental price.
- ◆ There is no additional charge for a wedding if an evening reception on the site is planned.
- ◆ No alcohol permitted for wedding ceremonies.

## Photographs

- ◆ All photographs are taken outdoors.
- ◆ Cost is \$50.
- ◆ Appointments must be made in advance.

**NOTE:** Use of the site may be disallowed by the site director based on scheduling pressures or conflicts, staffing requirements, potential damage to the site, and other considerations as deemed valid.

## Receptions & Parties

- ◆ Receptions are held from 5 pm - 10 pm during the months of June, July, and August. All receptions and/or parties are held outdoors.
- ◆ The site rental fee is \$4,000 plus a \$500 security deposit.
- ◆ Three months advance notice is required. A \$500 deposit will hold the date. Final payment is required 30 days prior to the event. All payments must be made by cash, checks, or money orders.
- ◆ Fees include the following:
  - Tables and chairs for up to 150 people
  - Tent
  - On-site personnel
- ◆ A receiving line through the Manor House can be arranged with advanced notice.
- ◆ There are no restroom facilities at site of reception. Restrooms are located in the Visitor Center. Additional facilities must be arranged by the individual renting the site.
- ◆ There are no on-site changing facilities.
- ◆ No smoking is permitted on-site.

## Catering

- ◆ Catering arrangements must be made by the individual renting the site.
- ◆ The caterer is required to meet with the Site Rental Coordinator prior to the event.
- ◆ The caterer must be off site by 11:00 p.m.
- ◆ No kitchen facilities or supplies are available on-site.
- ◆ Generator may be needed. Must be supplied by individual renting the site.

## Alcoholic Beverages

- ◆ Limited to evening use.
- ◆ Certificate of insurance for \$1 million listing The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and The Pennsbury Society as additional insured is required.

## Site Rental Information

- ◆ Three months advance notice is required.
- ◆ A meeting with the Site Rental Coordinator is required to confirm availability.

# Pennsbury Manor

Pennsbury Manor is the 17th-century reconstructed country estate of William Penn, founder and first governor of Pennsylvania. As the only residence of Penn that is open to the public, Pennsbury Manor interprets the accomplishments and life-styles of Penn, the social and cultural patterns of early Pennsylvania, and the role of reconstruction in the historical preservation movement. The present site was reconstructed in 1939 by the Commonwealth as a memorial to William Penn and today it represents a tangible link to the lives of those who lived in Pennsylvania from 1680 to 1720.

Today, Pennsbury Manor's unique collection of 17th-century artifacts and lively programs provide our visitor with an opportunity to step back in time and discover the story of Pennsylvania's beginnings.

Pennsbury Manor is administered by the Pennsylvania Historical & Museum Commission in cooperation with The Pennsbury Society, a private, non-profit organization dedicated to supporting this historic site and its programs.

# Directions

## FROM PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE

Exit 358 to Route 13 North; turn right at first traffic light onto Green Lane; left onto Radcliffe Street at the dead end; continue for 4.6 miles (road changes name twice: Main Street and Bordentown Road); between pair of lakes, then right onto Pennsbury Memorial Road. We are located at end of road.

## FROM I-95 (North or South)

Take Exit 46A (Route 1 North, Morrisville). Travel Route 1 North to the Route 13 South (Bristol) Exit. Exit at Tyburn Road East. Take a right at first traffic light New Ford Mill Road. Take a right at end of road onto Bordentown Road. Take first left onto Pennsbury Memorial Road. We are located at end of road.

## FROM ROUTE 1 (North or South)

Route 1 to Route 13 South (Bristol). Exit onto Tyburn Road East; travel approximately 2 miles to first traffic light and take a right onto New Ford Mill Road. Take a right at end of road onto Bordentown Road. Take first left onto Pennsbury Memorial Road. We are located at end of road.
